Dear Parents/Caregivers,

It is that time of year to make a commitment to Religious Education Classes for 2015-2016 at Saint Bernard Church.

Classes will meet every Sunday morning from 9:30 – 10:30 a.m. beginning September 13, 2015 in Zahn Hall for Kindergarten through 12th Grade for all children of the parish. There will be no classes on the weekends of Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Years, Palm Sunday and Easter.

As a practicing Catholic, you pledged at the Baptism of your child to family, friends and the faith community to educate your child in the Catholic faith. The gravely serious moral obligation and duty to ensure this pledge is honored and fulfilled lies primarily with you as their parent. The Christian faith community will assist in attaining this goal.

Parents of 7th & 8th grade Confirmation candidates must attend the first CCD session with their child for an overview of the Confirmation program, requirements, and to sign the Confirmation Contract. If parents are unable to participate in this session, arrangements must be made to meet with the Director of Religious Education in order for their child to be considered a candidate for Confirmation.

We ask that children arrive on time so classes may begin promptly. Donuts, juice, milk, and coffee will be available each week for children, parents and parishioners following the 8 a.m. Mass by our Knights of Columbus.
